- ***Tracing Tommy's History on the Western Front***

WFA East Coast's Greg Goodell recounts his November 2018 journey with two groups of living historians across the British sector Western Front during the centenary of the 1918 Armistice. He will share thoughts and reflections on the meaning of living history commemorations for the Great War community.

- ***Pershing's Compromise: The AEF and the Entente, 1918***

Based on his first book published by the Center of Military History and co-authored with WFA EC Branch Secretary Paul Cora, Branch Chairman Alexander Falbo-Wild presents the story of the AEF units which served closely with the Entente armies in the closing campaign of 1918.

- ***The Ordnance***

Quantico based scholar Bruce Gudmundsson presents a historical immersion problem on Britain's preparation for the Great War through the eyes of British Army's Sir Stanley Dunlop, Master of the Ordnance in 1913.

- ***Italy's Aerial Foreign Legion***

*Aviation History* Editor and prolific WW1 aviation author Jon Guttman presents the little known story of aviators of Italian descent who returned to Italy in World War 1 to fly and fight for Italy.

buffet luncheon!**

**When:** Saturday 15 June 2019. Doors open, refreshments, meet & greet 9:00AM with opening remarks at 10:00AM.


**Where:** Reckord Lounge, Fifth Regiment Armory, 219 29<sup>th</sup> Division Street, Baltimore, MD 21201
