The City of Buena Park recognizes Bells of Peace, a World War I Centennial Armistice Remembrance. A tolling of bells is a traditional expression of honor and remembrance. A century ago, 4.7 million American sons and daughters put on the uniform to serve our nation and the whole world in this global conflict. Men and women from our own fair community of Buena Park served selflessly and honorably in World War I. On the 11th hour, of the 11th day, of the 11th month in 1918, an armistice to the fighting was declared. The City of Buena Park does hereby call upon the citizens and institutions of our community to toll the bells in remembrance of the Armistice at 11:00 a.m. local time on November 11, 2018
