**WHEREAS:** A century ago 4.7 million American families sent their sons and daughters off to World War I; and

**WHEREAS:** The resources of our entire nation were brought to bear on the war effort; and

**WHEREAS:** 116,516 Americans gave their lives in the war, and more than 200,000 were wounded; and

**WHEREAS:** In November 2018 the world will commemorate the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Armistice that ended the fighting in World War I at 11:00 a.m., November 11, 1918 – the eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month; and

**WHEREAS:** The World War I Centennial Commission does hereby call upon all Americans across the nation to pause at 11:00 a.m. on November 11, 2018 and recognize, commemorate and give thanks for the service and sacrifice of those who served in World War I.
