- WHEREAS,** a tolling of a bells is a traditional expression of honor and remembrance; and
- WHEREAS,** a century ago, 4.7 million American sons and daughters put on the uniform to serve our nation and the world in this global conflict; and
- WHEREAS,** numerous men and women from the Idaho Falls community served selflessly and honorably in World War I; and
- WHEREAS,** there were 375,000 Americans wounded and 116,516 American deaths; and
- WHEREAS,** on the 11th hour, of the 11th day, of the 11 month in 1918, an armistice to the fighting was declared; and
- WHEREAS,** the U.S. World War One Centennial Commission has called upon all Americans across the nation to remember and give honor to all those who served; and
- WHEREAS** The City of Idaho Falls, Idaho wishes to remember and honor the service and sacrifice of the men and women who fought and died to preserve our country and protect our world from tyranny and injustice,

THEREFORE, I, REBECCA CASPER, MAYOR of the City of Idaho Falls call upon the citizens and institutions of our community to toll the bells in remembrance of the Armistice of November 11, 1918 at 11:00 a.m. local time on November 11, 2018.
