Executive Order **PROCLAMATION**

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

- WHEREAS,** a century ago 4.7 million American families sent their sons and daughters off to World War I; and
- WHEREAS,** the resources of our entire nation were brought to bear on the war effort; and
- WHEREAS,** 116,516 Americans gave their lives in the war and more than 200,000 were wounded; and
- WHEREAS,** in November 2018 the world will commemorate the 100th anniversary of the Armistice that ended the fighting in World War I at 11:00 a.m., November 11, 1918 – the eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month; and
- WHEREAS,** that the World War I Centennial Commission hereby calls upon Americans across the nation to pause at 11:00 a.m. on November 11, 2018 and recognize, commemorate and give thanks for the service and sacrifice of those who served in World War I;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, Eric J. Holcomb, Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim November 11, 2018 as**

in the State of Indiana, and invite all citizens to duly note this occasion.
