BELLS OF PEACE**

- WHEREAS,** A century ago 4.7 million American families sent their sons and daughters off to World War I; and
- WHEREAS,** The resources of our entire nation were brought to bear on the war effort; and
- WHEREAS,** 116,516 Americans gave their lives in the war, and more than 200,000 were wounded; and
- WHEREAS,** The tolling of bells is a traditional expression of honor and remembrance; and
- WHEREAS,** In November 2018 the world will commemorate the 100th anniversary of the Armistice that ended the fighting in World War I at 11:00 a.m., November 11, 1918 – the eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Pam Triolo, Mayor of the City of Lake Worth Florida, by virtue of the authority vested in me, do hereby proclaim

and call upon all Americans across the nation to toll bells in remembrance of those who served in World War I at 11:00 a.m. on November 11, 2018.
