and


WHEREAS: a century ago, 4.7 million American sons and daughters put on the uniform to serve our nation and the world in a global conflict. Men and women from the Town of Oyster Bay served selflessly and honorably in World War I. There were 375,000 casualties, including 116,516 deaths; and


WHEREAS: on the 11th hour, of the 11th day, of the 11th month in 1918, an armistice in the fighting was declared; and
